

Tipton County Public Library Hotspot Circulation Policy

The library will circulate wireless hotspots for the public to check out in accordance with the library's current Circulation Policy.

Equipment: Hotspot	14 days	1	No	\$1.00	\$105.00

- Hotspots may be borrowed by patrons 13 years or older.
- Hotspots may be placed on hold, but the library reserves the right to cancel a hold if a hotspot has been loaned to a patron's household (patrons with the same address on file) more than once in a 28-day period.
- Hotspots will be deactivated after the 14-day circulation period has expired.

In addition to the fine schedule above, the following fees may be assessed for hotspots or related equipment that has been damaged or not returned:

Power Adapter	\$10.00
USB Cable	\$5.00
Case	\$10.00
TOTAL COST	\$105.00
